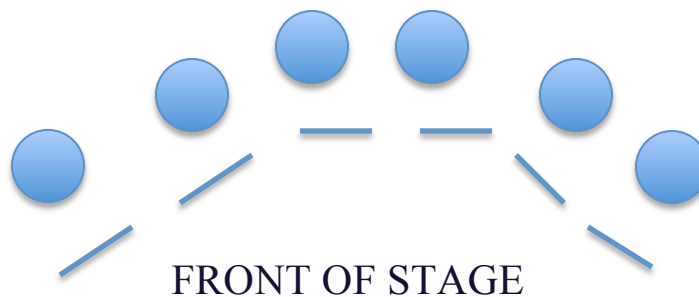

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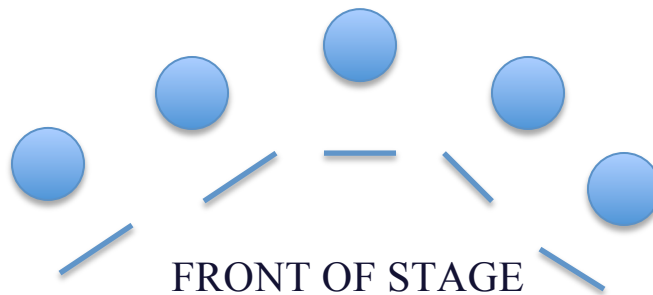
CLASSICAL GUITAR

- HS ensemble needs 6 chairs and 6 stands. Light amplification is preferred - 6 mics would be good if that many are available, otherwise 3 is ok.



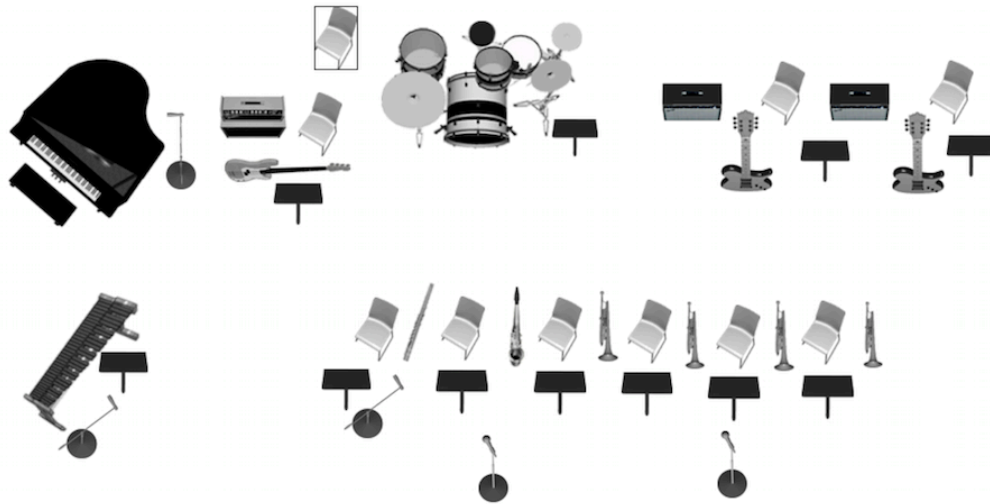
HS JAZZ GUITAR:
